MAREK ARNOLD'S ARTROCK PROJECT – The Triple EP Collection - CD TF VÖ 50

This Triple EP Collection is packed! However, it's not yet the highly anticipated second album of Marek Arnold's Artrock Project, but rather a budget-friendly interim product for CD lovers. The tracks and versions have been compiled from ones that were previously only available online. In addition, there are two completely new tracks, both featuring wonderful guest artists (see below). The CD, filled to the brim with 78 minutes of music, is expected to be available from mailorders at a mid-range price, and will be released as a limited edition.

Following the extremely successful and highly acclaimed debut album (2023) from Marek Arnold's Artrock Project, three EPs were released on digital online platforms, and three breathtaking videos from an AI studio appeared on YouTube. Each of the EPs includes versions of main tracks that were not yet available on CD, as well as parts of the "Berlin 2049 Suite." The interesting videos accompanying the EPs can be easily accessed via QR codes in the CD booklet. Some of the outstanding reviews of the 2023 studio album can be found on the middle page of the booklet and at the end of this information. All three digital EPs have been fully incorporated into this CD.

- (#1-3) The first EP, released in June 2023, features the track "Stay," sung by Melanie Mau. The anthem of the Artrock Festival in Reichenbach is presented here in both the short radio version and the extended version, which includes no fewer than six solos. That's prog!
- (#4-6) The second EP, released in September 2023, features "Papillon," sung by **Arno Menses** (Sieges Even / Subsignal). This track clocks in at 10 minutes and has, as expected, made a big impact. A true prog hit, the audio track and video have garnered the highest number of views.
- (#7-10) Just before Christmas, in December 2023, the third EP was released. The ballad "A Time Of Mystery," sung by Manuel Schmid (Stern Combo Meissen), is once again accompanied by a stunning AI

video. Finally, the unusual "Piano & Vocal" version is now available on CD.

(#11) With the EPs now complete, a previously hard-to-find extended version of "Come Away With Me" rounds off the tracks from the 2023 album. An **exclusive**, high-quality video featuring singer **Zeynah** can be viewed via a QR code in the CD booklet. After all the AI-driven fantasy, this is a real gem, with a real singer on screen.

(#12) "El Morisco y la Bruja de Nagu," fusion prog with Marek Arnold on saxophone. The Finnish artist **Riitala** allowed us to include this exciting track on the CD.

(#13) Annemarie Schmidt is the name of this talented singer, who has performed with Ed Sheeran on stage before, and reached the finals of THE VOICE Germany too. Marek has known her since her school days and invited her to the studio to record the moving ballad "Still The World Keeps Moving." Exclusive, only for this CD!

(#14) Once again, a longer track. Patrik Lundström (Ritual / Kaipa), Steve Bühring, and Jana Pöche share vocals on "Aiden." The fantasy lyrics, written by Guy Manning, bring us back to the topic of Al. Artificial intelligence (Al) is now fully established and living among us as families — a continuation of the "Berlin 2049 Suite" story, from last year's studio album. Also exclusive, only on this CD!
